

## CROCHETED WINDMILL MARKET BAG

### MATERIALS:

4 balls Plymouth Jeanne Worsted (you may choose 4 different colors or any combination you wish.

Size H crochet hook, or any size to give you a firm fabric.

Yarn needle for seaming.

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical, but a firm fabric of 4.5 to 5 sc = 1" is desirable.

### Begin with Panel 1:

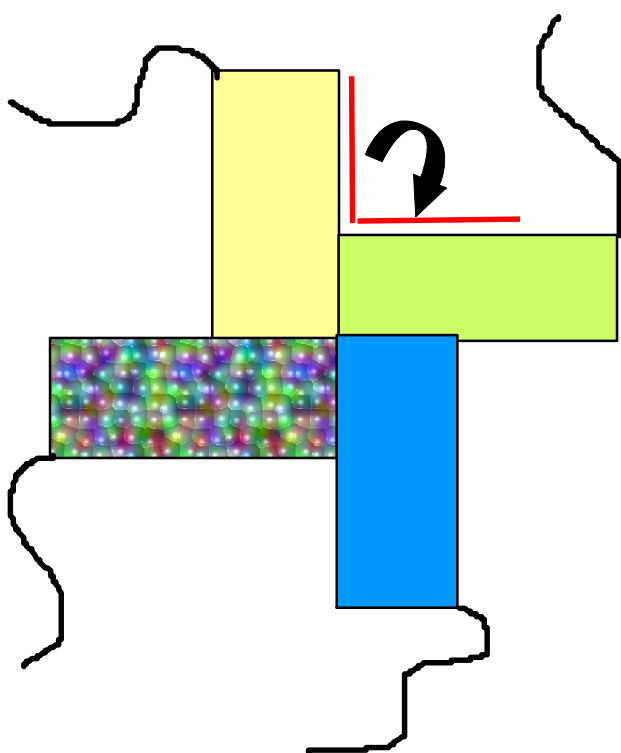
Ch 26. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across: 25 sc. \*Work 75 rows of sc or until desired length. (You want to reserve at least 10 feet of yarn to make a handle on each panel.) Handle: At end of last row, ch 61. Sl St in each ch across back to top corner of bag. Sl St in one or two additional stitches of panel for strength. Secure yarn, cut and weave in end. One (1) panel completed.

### Panel 2:

With Panel 1 facing you, and handle at the upper left-hand corner, join 2nd ball of yarn at lower right-hand corner. Working across ends of rows, work 2 sc in end of each row for a total of 25 sc. Turn and repeat from \* as for Panel 1. The diagram below may be helpful.

### Panel 3 & 4:

Repeat as for Panel 2. Seam the cast on edge of Panel 1 to the side of Panel 4. Seam sides of bags together (again, see diagram below). Weave in all ends. Tie handles together any way you wish and enjoy!



The diagram at left shows the placement of the four panels. You can see where the green panel begins - at the bottom right-hand corner of the yellow panel. The red lines show where the side seams are sewn.
